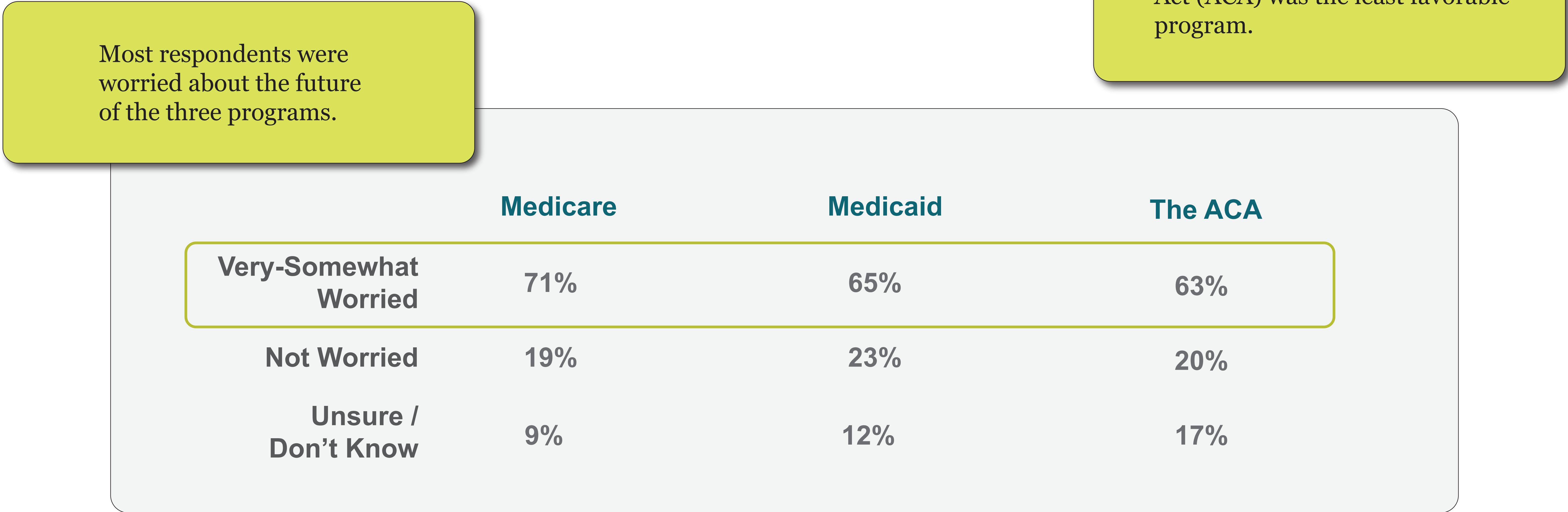
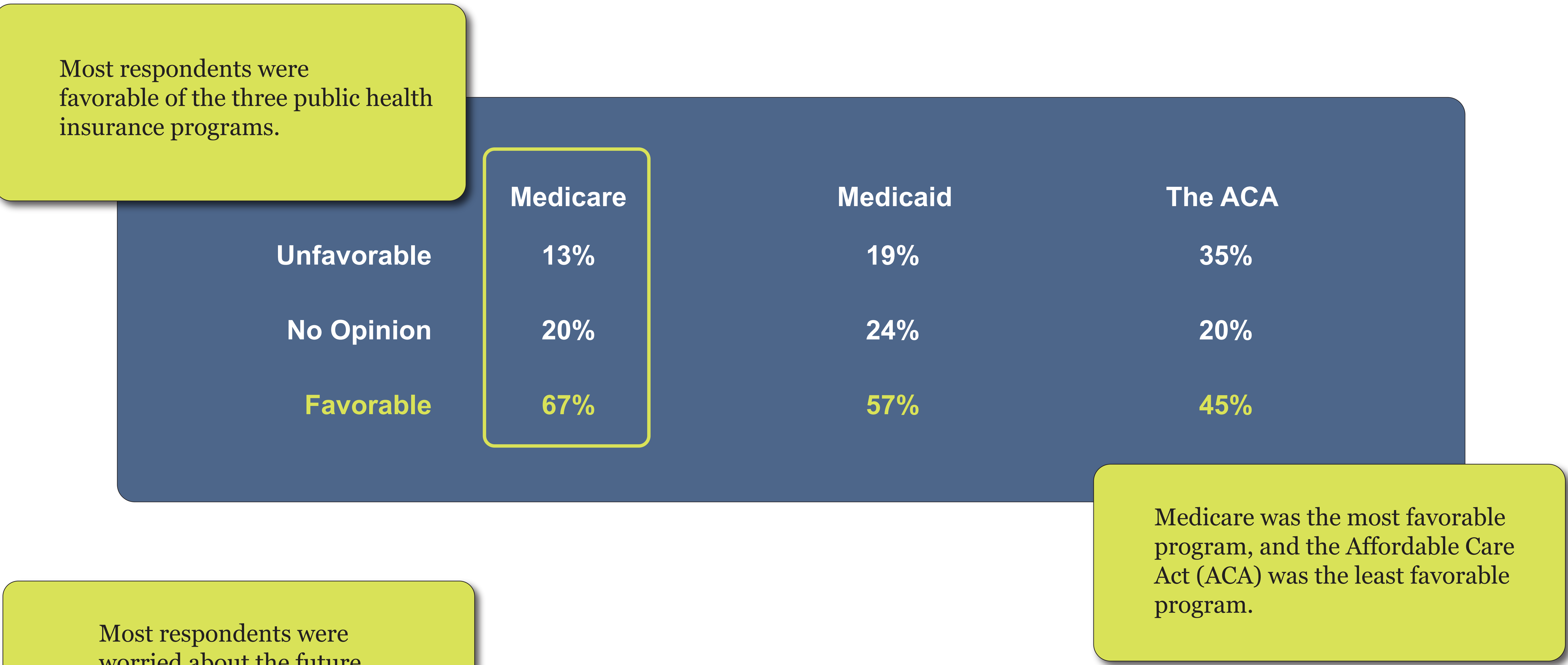
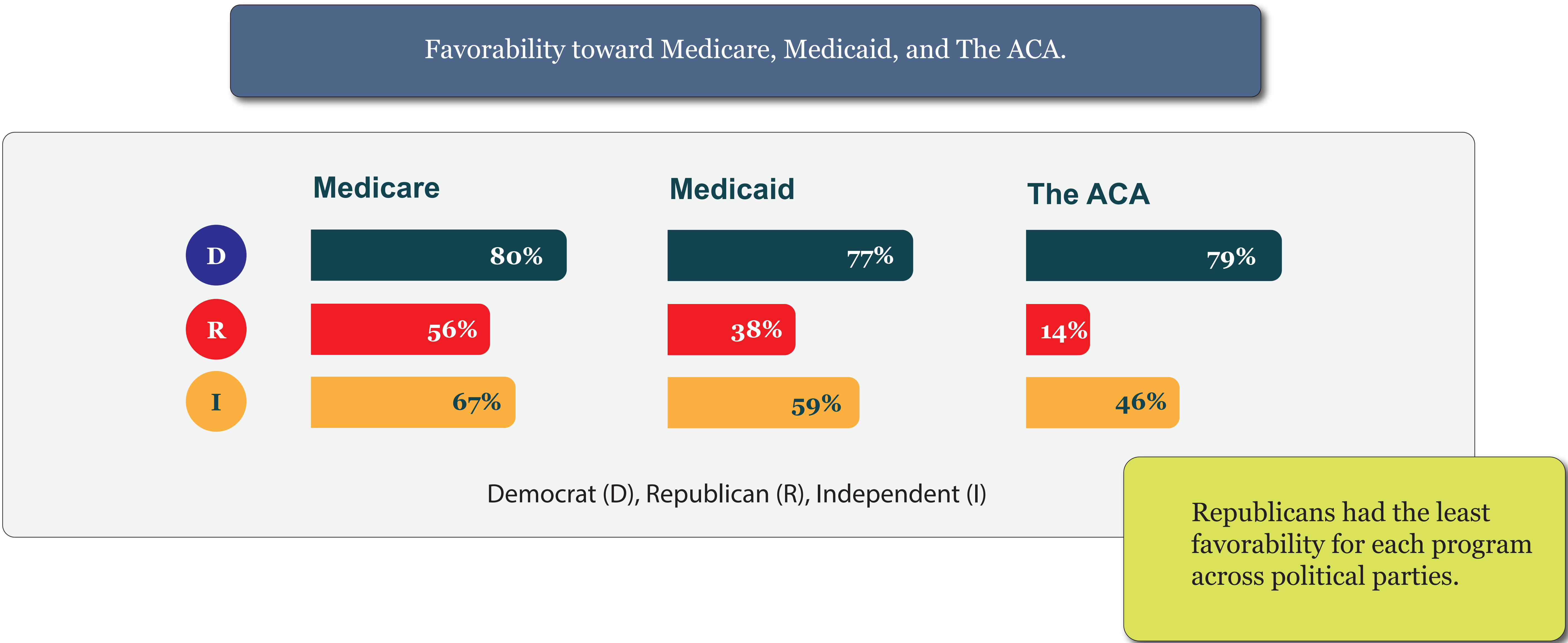


Most Michiganders are Worried about Cuts to Public Insurance



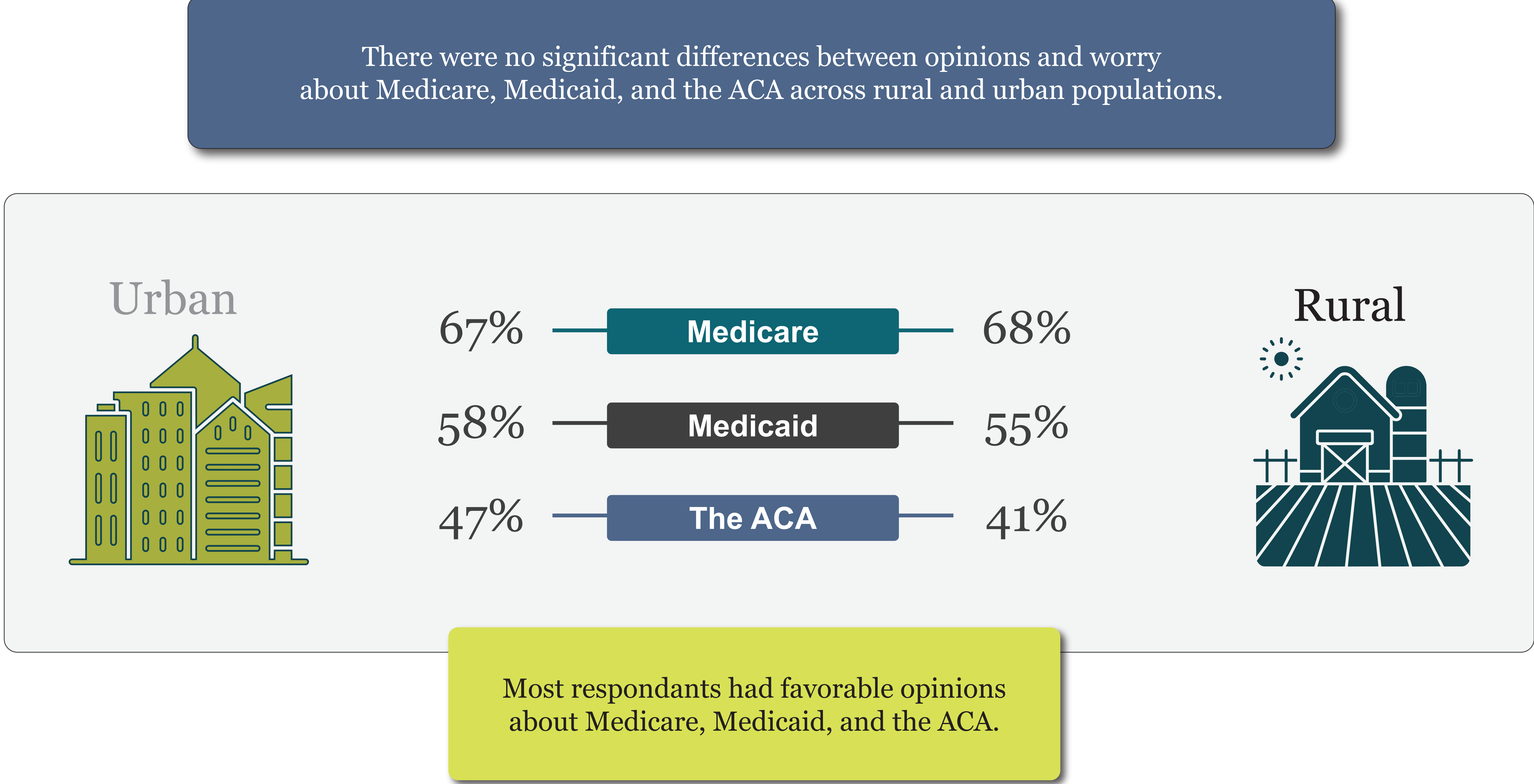
And Favorability Aligns Along Party Lines
